## **Beowulf Cluster**

The TCC has created a 24-node Beowulf cluster. (Beowulf clusters are used to develop parallel programming applications.) The Campus Computing Committee will award access to the Beowulf Cluster based upon research proposals. The proposal forms can be obtained in room 117 of the Speare building. There will be no charge for this service.

## **SAS 9.1 Installed**

Because of the good response from our users to our last Hotline, we have decided to keep the SAS software. Version 9.1 of SAS has been installed on the TCC computers.

## **Ansys 8 Installed**

Version 8 of Ansys has been installed on the TCC computers. Note that Ansys 5.7.1 will still be available to assist in conversions.

## **Free Alumni Accounts**

The TCC is happy to announce that Alumni of NMT are now eligible for a no-cost web-mail web-only computer account. These accounts are being made available to those who have graduated from NMT as an earned benefit.

E-mail access is available through either NMT's web-mail system or via POP (download). You will be able to check your email from the Internet and keep in touch with your friends from NMT.

The account will also allow you to host a web page with a 25MB quota that can be accessed via the web or FTP.

This account is for e-mail and web access **only** and **does not** include TCC modem dial-in access, printing, licensed software, or local system login. If you still need this type of access, you can continue with your existing type of Alumni account.
