* Minimum TAs are for 7.5 weeks in summer. Minimum summer RAs are based on a 3 month contract. Domestic TAs and RAs may work for 40 hours per week in summer (double minimums and maximums). For international students, summer-long stipends may exceed the Spring semester stipend by no more than 60% per pay period.

** PIs should provide for annual step increases of ~7% for stipends and tuition.

Tuition (charged at In-state rates for those on contracts signed before close of registration) and fees are the responsibility of the student.

Tuition - Regular student load for 9 months =	\$3,959.46
Tuition - Regular nonresident student load for 9 months =	\$12,733.74
Tuition - Regular student summer (6 cr.) load =	\$1,319.82
Resident Tuition/credit hour =	\$219.97
Non-resident Tuition/credit hour (> 6 cr.) =	\$707.43
