NEW MICROFORM PRINTER READER

Since the copier digitizes the image, in the near future, we intend to attach a computer to the system so that images can be downloaded as well as printed. We are grateful to President Lopez for making this addition possible.

PAY PER VIEW

The Library is undertaking a pilot project to allow New Mexico Tech Faculty the opportunity to obtain articles from Elsevier ScienceDirect journals to which the Library does not subscribe. The Elsevier Company is known for its Science, Technology, and Medicine publications. This "Pay-Per-View" option allows faculty to acquire only the articles they need without the Library having to buy the entire subscription.
