## **Login64**

A new UNIX server, named login64.nmt.edu, is available for use. It runs the 64-bit version of Fedora Core version 11. As we receive 64-bit versions of our licensed third-party software, we will install them on login64. However, not all vendors have released 64-bit versions of their software as of this date.

## **Elmo Cameras**

We have installed Elmo Cameras in Workman 101, Speare 23, and Speare 4. These cameras are connected to the ceiling mounted projectors and are selected through the KVM (Keyboard-Video-Mouse) switch located in the Instructor Station.

## **LCDs for Instructor Stations**

The old CRT monitors attached to Instructor Stations in JonesA-101, MSEC-103, MSEC-105, Weir 102, Weir 128, and Weir 209 have been replaced with 19 inch LCD screens.

## **FTP deinstalled**

The TCC will be removing all access to ftp.nmt.edu on December 21, 2009. (This will not affect sftp access or sftp.nmt.edu.)

Due to security issues, the TCC restricted FTP access in 2006. Until 2007, legacy users were still able to update files by direct login to infohost.nmt.edu. However, it was impossible for new users to upload files to the FTP server. All new user web files are located in ~/public\_html directories.

If you have data on our FTP server, please move your files to your ~/public\_html folder. User web pages that begin with http://infohost.nmt.edu/~username are NOT affected. Only access to ftp.nmt.edu is being removed.
